# **EFNIL**

The European Federation of National Institutions for Language (EFNIL) is an organisation consisting of the central or national institutions for research, documentation and policy relating to the officially recognised standard languages within the member states of the European Union (EU). Comparable language institute of other European countries are associate members.

The Federation was founded in Stockholm in October 2003, and seeks to promote European linguistic diversity with particular reference to the national/official languages of the European Union.

## **The purpose of EFNIL is:**

- the promotion of multilingualism in the EU and plurilingualism amongst its citizens;
- the collection and exchange of information about the officially recognised standard languages of the EU;
- the provision of expert advice about language policy in the EU.

The Federation also maintains an interest in the minority and regional languages of Europe.

EFNIL is an independent organisation which seeks to achieve these objectives through collaboration between the major language institutions of the member states of the EU and other European countries.
